Discussion Questions

How are your choices today the same choices that the people of Zechariah’s time? (V.1-2) Are the consequences the same?

Read Ezekiel 34. How is this passage similar to the language of Zechariah in chapter 10-11?

How does Jesus use this same imagery in John 10 to explain who He is and His relationship to the people?

Read I Peter 5:1-4. How does Peter use this same imagery to describe how we respond to the shepherd?

Think about how chapter 11:12-13 was written 500 years before Jesus and Judas stand together in an upper room. Now read John 13:21-30. What new insights do you find in these familiar scenes?

Think about Jesus shepherding the doomed flock of chapter 11. How does Jesus lead, teach, and respond to a flock most of which will choose another shepherd?
