Discussion Questions

Read Phil 3:8-14. How do the sufferings of persecution in the Day of the Lord in which we live prepare us for the end of this day when persecution will be over forever? Romans 8:37

Read Gen 8:22, Zech 12:1, Matt 24:29, and Rev 21:22-23. How do these pictures emerge to show God's sovereignty over His creation; it's beginning, existence, and end. Does this give you confidence and hope for the future?

Read Deut 6:4-5. This is part of a prayer that was/is recited by the Jewish people morning and night every day of their lives. It was the first prayer learned by children and the last to be recited before death. How does it resonate with Zech 14:9 and the end?

Zechariah 14 looks to a day when all nations will join in Sukkot (The Festival of Booths). How does the rejoicing of Sukkot look in the kingdom of heaven? Rev 5:9-10.

As a kingdom of priests (Rev 1:5-6) how are we to mediate the new covenant in the blood of Christ with an unsaved world?
