How does Simon's lack of hospitality demonstrate the condition of his heart? V.36

Discuss the idea that we know more about Simon in this story than we do about the woman. Like the centurion's slave and the widow's son, she melts into the background of the story. Why?

How does your love for Jesus show in the way you stand at His feet? Read v.37-38. I am not asking about emotional displays but I am asking about love demonstrated.
