Discussion Questions**

When the church of God abandons the truth and principles of God what happens to the society? How does Jesus address this issue in Matthew 5:13-16?

How does sin cause us to abandon our inheritance in Christ? What does sin steal from us both in the short run and the long run?

How is Micah's loss (18:24) a picture of what happens when we abandon God as king in our lives? How does Jesus address this in Matthew 7:24-27?

Discuss Dan's killing of the people of Laish and how it demonstrates the folly of the idea that might makes right and polls make laws. How were Stalin and Hitler both examples of majority rule gone wrong?
