Weekly Memory Verse: "for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior who is Christ the Lord."

Think about the emotions of that first Christmas Eve as Mary's contractions begin and Joseph has nowhere to go but the stable. What must it have felt like to be part of God's story that night?

Thinking of the "inn" as meaning a guest room in someone's (a relative) house, how does that change the feel of the statement there was "no room"? Does it matter that the inn was not a sterile corporate Hilton?

How does it change your thinking that the presence of God did not hover over a mercy seat in the Holy of Holies of Herod's Temple in Jesus time?

Read Haggai 2:1-10. How does this prophecy find it's fulfillment symbolically in Herod's renovation of Zerubbabel's Temple and in reality as Jesus walks its grounds?

How is Haggai 2 yet to be fulfilled in the coming Kingdom of God?
Read Revelation 21:10-27

Think about the three titles Jesus is given "Savior", "Messiah" and "Lord". How does each title relate to you and your walk as a disciple?
