Discussion Questions

The story of Herod and Herodias reads like a first century soap opera. How do you think Luke sets their sin (v.18-20) against the picture of the Redeemer baptized in the Jordan?

What do you think it would have been like to be a person coming to the Jordan to be baptized and then witness the opening of the heavens in verse 22?

While that miracle obviously impacted some why do you think so many more of those along the shoreline still rejected Jesus as Messiah?

Look at the genealogy of Jesus. Why do you suppose God chose to set this list in the text of scripture for all time? We often just skip over it. Why is it important for us to study and think about?

Read Jeremiah 22:24-27 and Haggai 2:23. How is God's redemptive work in Zerubbabel a foreshadowing of not only Jesus coming but also His redemptive work for all mankind?
