Discussion Questions

Weekly Memory Verse: *“May the Lord reward your work, and our wages be full from the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to seek refuge.” Ruth 2:12*

The writer gives us a glimpse of what is to come when Boaz is revealed in verse 1. How is our life a day to day revealing of what God has already prepared for us? Is God plotting for your provision when you are not watching?

What risk does Ruth take (v.9, v.22) as a widow and a Moabite in gleaning the fields to care for Naomi and herself? How does God undertake to protect these faithful women?

Read Exodus 22:22-24; Lev 19:9-10; James 1:27. As you read these verses what do you think it says to us about taking care of the weakest and most vulnerable around us?

How does Boaz demonstrate tangibly the character and concern of God for His people?

Ruth asks Boaz the question in the book “why?” in verse 12. How do we see here a picture of the grace of God that has been poured out on us as “foreigners”?

How do you see God’s providential hand at work in Ruth and Naomi’s story? How do you see Him at work in your story?
