*Weekly Memory Verse: Then a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, My Chosen One; listen to Him!" Luke 9:35*

How is the scene here in Luke 9:28-32 repeated in Matthew 26:36-46? What similarities do you see?

Read Luke 9:29 and then Rev 21:22- 22:5. How is this moment a picture of who Jesus was, is, and evermore shall be throughout eternity?

Read Phil 2:5-8; Col 1:15-20; John 1:9-13; Hebrews 2:9-18. How do each of these reveal a little more of God's plan and the reality we see revealed on the mountain?

How is the transfiguration a "passing of the baton" from the age of the Law and the Prophets to the Church Age?

What must have it been like for Moses and Elijah to stand with Jesus on the Mount and talk about the Cross? Read Revelation 4:5- 5:14. What was it like in heaven when they saw this played out?

Peter wants to stay on the mountain – have you ever felt like that in a moment of worship or revelation?

Read Matthew 24:29-41. How is this moment also a foreshadowing of Jesus return at the end of the age He is now beginning?
