Weekly Memory Verse: ...for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior who is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11

A W Tozer writes “I am positively sure after many years of observation and prayer that the basis of all of our trouble today, in religious circles, is that our God is too small.” How is this true?

What is the difference between God being small and us seeing Him as small? Read Psalm 34:3. Think about magnifying the Lord now as a microscope makes small things big but as a telescope helps us to see big things that seem small.

How does life, suffering, and struggle make us seem small in our own eyes like the Israelites who spied out the promised land in Numbers 13:33.

Read Psalm 46. How does this speak to our smallness in relation to the world we live in but the bigness of our God?

How can we begin to see God as big as He really is?
