The Gospel According to Luke The New Covenant Luke 22:7-23

Weekly Memory Verse: "And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood." Luke 22:20

Judas was looking for a place away from the crowds to betray Jesus (22:6). Why might Jesus have given the cryptic "a man will meet you carrying a jar of water" instead of being more direct about the home in which He would eat the Passover?

Think about preparing a Passover meal for the 12 (or possibly many more). What do you think the day was like for Peter and John?

Read Isaiah 53 and 2 Cor 5:21. How does this change your reading of Jesus' words "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me"?

Judas was placed in the seat of the honored guest at the right hand of Jesus at the table. Why might Jesus have placed him there?

The matzah is called the "bread of affliction" representing the people's time in Egypt. Jesus calls Himself the Bread of Life. How are both of these breads shadowed in the showbread of the tabernacle/Temple?

Read Jeremiah 31:27-40. Ezekiel 34. How is the New Covenant portrayed by the prophets of the OT?
