Five Questions  
Luke 10:25-42**

*Weekly Memory Verse: "You have answered correctly; do this and you shall live." Luke 10:28*

The first question in this text is the right question "What shall I do to inherit eternal life?" How would you answer this question today if someone asked you?

The second question is Jesus' question "what is written in the text?" How does the text of scripture guide the answer you just gave? What **questions might you ask** to lead a person to faith in Jesus?

The third question is about legal technicality. How is being a "good person" not enough when it comes to loving God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength?

The fourth question forces us to face our failures. How do our weaknesses lead us to Jesus? Read 2 Cor 11:7-10. How does Paul see even physical weakness as leading us to Jesus?

In the fifth question we see the argument of Luke the writer being resolved. How is Mary a picture of what it means "to inherit the Kingdom of God?"
