Luke 13:22-35**

Weekly Memory Verse: "Strive to enter by the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able." Luke 13:24

How do we separate the "striving to enter the narrow door" from a works based salvation? How hard is it to follow Christ and not follow the mainstream of the world?

How does verse 25 resonate with the passage in Genesis 7:11-16?

When you think about Jesus wanting (longing) to gather His people and they "would not have it!" how does that compare to your life and the world around you?
