Weekly Memory Verse: Thus says the Lord of hosts, "Consider your ways." Haggai 1:5

Read Ezekiel 10-11. How do we see both the discipline of the Lord promised in Habakkuk and Ezekiel 10 brought to hope in Ezekiel 11? How is discipline different from punishment?

Read Ezekiel 33:1-7. How has God made each of us a watchman for our time and culture?

In what ways have you miss-prioritized your own life to focus more on your own comfort than on being a disciple and making disciples? Where are your priorities correct?

How can focus on Kingdom priorities make us more content in whatever circumstances we find ourselves? Think about the Apostle Paul's example. I Cor 11:21-12:13
