*Weekly Memory Verse: "I have come to cast fire on the earth; and how I wish it were already kindled!" Luke 12:49*

Do you ever look around you at the suffering in the world and think "they are getting what they deserve"? What would happen if that were true and we all got "what we deserve" from God?

Suffering is part of living in a world broken by sin. How is God's allowance of another year v.8-9 in this broken world a true act of mercy and grace? What is He allowing for?

The message of Christ (Isaiah 61) is a message of freedom, healing, and hope. How do our lives reflect that message every day to a world bent over by the bondage of the adversary?
