Discussion Questions**

***Weekly Memory Verse: "Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of Hosts" Zech 4:6b***

Think about the picture of a crown being placed on the head of the high priest Joshua. How is this a picture of who Jesus is as our high priest and king? Read Hebrews 4:14-16.

Re-read Zech 4:1-14. How is the lampstand a picture of the ministry of Jesus as the light of the world? Read John 1:1-4; John 8:12.

Read Revelation 17-18. How is Babylon here used as a representation of all sin and its destruction as prophesied in Zechariah's sixth and seventh visions?

Read Revelation 20:11-15. How is the vision of the scroll leading us to see sin not as a cultural thing but as a personal one? Compare that to national discipline in the captivity in Babylon.

Read Matthew 25. How are the small acts of our lives in teaching children, feeding the poor, seeking the lost, and healing the broken small steps in the larger plan of God in the return of Jesus?
