Weekly Memory Verse: *“The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former, says the Lord of Hosts, and in this place I will give peace...” Haggai 2:9*

Read Ezra 3:11-13. In the beginning the cry of the elders who had seen the glory of Solomon's Temple was drowned out by the young people zeal in worship. How does their negativity become a cancer that grows to stop the work?
