Weekly Memory Verse: Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving: Col 4:2

Why do you think it matters that we are praying for open doors for the word in our community and in the world?

When we pray for a clear presentation of the word of God how do we expect God to fulfill that prayer? What part do we play?

Are you "devoted" to prayer in your life? Are you devoted to prayer that God would open doors for the gospel for you to walk through? What needs to change in your prayer life?

How do we fall asleep in our prayer life for the spread of the gospel message?
