**Discussion Questions**

***Weekly Memory Verse: Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than men. Col 3:23***

Discuss the idea of marriage, parenting and serving as the picture of a circle dance with God. Read John 17:22-23 how does this passage reveal the heart of the circle dance?

How does seeing the family as a radical new representation of the character and glory of God change your view of everyday life together?

Why are the words submit and sacrifice so difficult as we think of life together in marriage?

How is marriage today supposed to reflect the idea of marriage before the fall? How are we to respond?

Think about the reciprocal pieces to all of these commands. How does the dance get easier if we simply let God lead?
